



Strategic Alliances (2018 - 2023)




Strategic Partners (New 2022-23)




Alignment with Technical Programs

The strategic partners are distributed throughout the 7 Technical Cooperation Programs as follows:



Examples of Success – GCF

Accredited: July 2021 – ability to access resources for development of projects (USD 50M) Partnership: September 2021 - legal arrangement for climate resilience projects in LAC



Caribbean: Strengthening the foundations of the agricultural sector to respond to climate change.

Latin America: Green Recovery for food, health and water security post-COVID-19 reinforced by financial and technological innovation.

Ecuador: Strengthening the capacities of the Development Bank of Ecuador (DBE) to support its accreditation to the GCF.

Brazil: Improving capacity to support the development of a national program for sustainable solid waste management in the coastal zone.

Brazil: Mitigation and adaptation to climate change under agroforestry systems in cocoa production in the Amazon and Atlantic Forest biomes.

Examples of Success - AGRA

ALLIANCE FOR A GREEN REVOLUTION IN AFRICA

SEP 2021 - Signing of agreement, joint promotion of both institutions for the recovery of fertile soils, the fight against poverty and hunger, and the transformation of agri-food systems in their respective regions.

JAN 2022 - First Africa-Americas High-Level Round Table: "Building Bridges for Future Cooperation on Agrifood Systems".

JUL 2022 - First Summit of Ministers of Africa and the Americas to promote cooperation on agrifood issues. Organized by IICA, the African Union Development Agency-New Partnership for Africa's Development (AUDA-NEPAD) and AGRA.

SEP 2022 - Forum in Rwanda with IICA participation emphasizes that joint Africa-America cooperation is key to global food security.

APR 2023 - **Interregional Ministerial Roundtable on Digitalization and Investment in Food Systems Transformation** in Vietnam. Organized by AGRA, Grow Asia and Food Action Alliance, together with IICA and the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development of Vietnam.



Some Successful Examples -Academia + Private Sector + CSO (Hemispheric Rural Youth Community) This hemispheric rural youth community (CHJR) is a virtual space provided to young people of the Americas, which seeks to enhance their skills and participation as agents of change to improve Agrifood Systems.



Examples of Success - Private Sector + Academia

Living Soils of the Americas An initiative that links science, public policy, the private sector and soil restoration work in the Hemisphere, whose degradation threatens the position of Latin America and the Caribbean as a guarantor of global food security.


